Dear Bridgescape Schools Families, Students and Staff,

As news about the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) evolves and new cases increase daily across the State of Ohio and the country, we want to let you know that our Governor, Mike DeWine has cancelled all classes at all k-12 schools in the state for three weeks. This order begins Monday, March 16 and continues through Friday, April 3. **All Ohio Bridgescape Schools will remain open on Friday, March 13.**

Beginning Monday, March 16, all classes and school related activities are cancelled for three weeks through April 3. **The only exception is the skilled trades program.** All students in the skilled trades training program are asked to arrive at the school at 11:00 am where the van will continue to pick you up for training. Please forward any questions or concerns about that to your guidance counselor. The school will be open Monday, March 16, 2020 from 9am – 12 pm for students to come and pick up paperwork for classes that can be completed over the extended break.

Bridgescape administrators will continue to monitor the development of COVID-19 in partnership with local, state and federal health and government officials. We will reach out to all families every Friday from now through April 3 with updates and information via phone and text. Anticipate invitations to the Remind Me app from your advisors as they may also communicate updates with you, as appropriate.
